

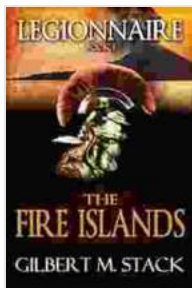

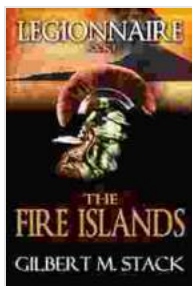
Review

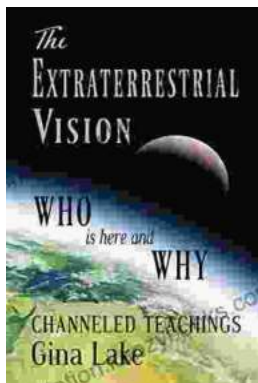

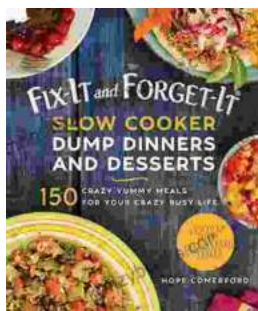
